Thank you for extending the period to make written comments on the proposed vacation of Luma Vista Drive.

Luma Vista Drive accesses land that is presently owned by the City of Scappoose and is slated to become a city park that can be enjoyed by many. Additionally, the city has logged the property from time to time using Luma Vista as access. The proposal to vacate certainly does not appear to be in the public's best interest. In fact, it doesn't fit the heading of the county rules for vacation:

"A road vacation is the right to abandon or give up the public's right to the use of a road or a road right-of-way that is no longer needed for transportation"

I hope our commissioners will give this matter serious consideration. When we don't follow our own rules in one case, we set ourselves up for problems in the future.
