**ORDER NO. 51-2023** 

WHEREAS, a majority of the Board of County Commissioners finds that undue harm will result to the McNulty Creek Bridge on Ross Road at mile post 0.88, in the event vehicles in excess of a maximum weight of are permitted to travel on the county road, because of the risk of bridge failure if regularly used by vehicles in excess of 10,000 pounds; and

WHEREAS, The Roadmaster has presented this Application and Order to restrict the use of said road in accordance with the requirements of the Columbia County Transportation Ordinance

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY ORDERS:

- 1. The McNulty Creek Bridge on Ross Road at mile post 0.88 shall be closed to vehicular traffic with a maximum weight in excess of 10,000 pounds.
- 2. The Roadmaster shall post the road conspicuously at each end of the section affected by this order and endorse this order accordingly.
- 3. This order shall be effective upon recording in the Commissioners' Journal, after the fact of posting has been properly endorsed.
