Discussion on Solid Waste Division Updates

- Sharps Container Exchange Program
 - Issues with RFPD sharps Rainier, Mist-Birkenfeld
 - Hudson handling of sharps with new hauling contractor
 - Contractor building new facility in Clackamas Autoclave system/facility

• Dump Stoppers Program

 Reasons for less cases and vehicles this year compared to previous years; Smith Rd cases have gone down

• Nuisance Abatement progress

- Summary of nuisance abatement costs thus far and total cost projections
- o Plans for vehicle disposal

Transfer Station

- o TS repairs: all pumps working, fence repair is next
- TS improvements: upgraded roof along main building contractor quotes need engineered drawings included

- Asbestos Dropbox: everyone is generally impressed with convenience and cost of sample testing
- Annual Waste Tonnage: Cascades facility closed November of last year; 3-4 boxes delivered to TS daily. This is a significant amount of weight that affected our annual tonnage
 - New Gable Rd apartment complex waste material dramatically affected tonnage as well
- o ORPET material: still working together on solution that works for all parties involved
 - WM delivered new 40-yd box to divert shredded material
 - Still interested in exploring alternate hauling options that don't include tipping material on tipping floor

• Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program

- Upcoming events in August, October, and November
- June HHW event was probably busiest ever with almost 250 vehicles
- o Updates to surveys, digital data tracking and where to show QR code at TS events

• DEQ's Opportunity to Recycle Reports

- Plans for social media posts and in-person event recycling and waste reduction education this year
- County fair was successful but mostly interacted with children who came up to spin the wheel and had minimal discussion with most adults about recycling
- Looking to attend different event this fall for Halloween/Recycling themed education
- Discussion on a Columbia County master-recycler course available for residents. Brandon recommended this based on PSU's master recycler program
 - PSU's Community Environmental Services does waste audits
 - Program could be flexible to employee's schedule and time available
 - OSU Online Master Recyclers could be good reference
 - Volunteer mechanism for ReUse center
 - Survey on social media to see how many residents would be interested

RMA and ORSOP Survey

- Received data and help with answering questions from Josh B
- Overall, the survey was a bit confusing and largely a team effort, however, we did our best to provide CAA with details needed regarding each city and unincorporated county's recycling logistics
- o RMA is still supposedly beginning in Summer 2025
- Next is ORSOP interview with CAA's contractor RRS

• Pilot ReUse Program Updates

- o Presenting the program to the board in the next few weeks
- Program and new TS employee schedule will be Tues. Saturday 8am-5pm
- Need to follow up w/NWCS and other vendors for shipping container quotes
